

How to Prevent Carpenter Ants Infestation







The first step to prevent recurrence of any pest infestation is to seal all the gaps and cracks in your house and office. This includes wire holes and utility pipes which penetrate the walls. Also seal gaps surrounding all electric outlets to **Prevent Carpenter Ants** from invading.

2 Fix water leakages and moisture problems both indoors and outdoors. Look around for damp wood and be sure to either replace or repair them.

3 You shouldn't have any tree stump in your garden. Make sure you have them mulched or just ship them. In any case, you shouldn't have any wooden debris around the house.




4 Make certain that your stock of firewood is not kept too near your building. You don't even want them touching the walls.

5 Check the trees in your garden thoroughly and make sure that their branches do not touch walls or roof of the building. This makes it harder for carpenter ants and other pests to find a way inside.



6 Keep your house neat and clean to deter these pests from making a nest. Damp and dirty places make a perfect breeding ground for ants. Keep food in sealed containers, regularly clean the floors, and fix leaky taps that might dampen the cabinets beneath them.

7 Clean out your cat litter box regularly as it might provide a shelter for carpenter ants when not in use. Make your home as unfriendly as you can for these pests.
